

## SUSANA MALCORRA

Former Foreign Minister of Argentina



Susana Malcorra served as Minister of Foreign Affairs and Worship of the Argentine Republic from 2015 to 2017, under President Mauricio Macri. She also served as an advisor to President Macri where she presided over the Eleventh WTO Ministerial Conference held in Buenos Aires.

Previously, Ms. Malcorra has held several leadership roles within the United Nations. She served as Chief of Staff to Secretary-General Ban Ki-Moon and also

worked as Undersecretary-General of the Department of Field Support, where she was charged with providing logistics, communications, personnel, and financial support services to UN peacekeeping operations all over the world. Additionally, she was Chief Operating Officer of the World Food Programme.

Earlier in her career, Ms. Malcorra spent more than two decades in the private sector. She began her corporate career as a Systems Engineer in IBM eventually moving to become the CEO of Telecom Argentina, the third largest company in the country at the time.

She holds a degree in Engineering from the University of Rosario.
